Doon heritage school was established in 2013 with a very humble beginning to impart quality education in this remote area. DHS has always been humble and paid gratitude to all those who joined hands with us to make this place an apt place for excellence in education and rooting thru culture and heritage. It is a unique vision to be fulfilled with the support of local residents of this beautiful area.

Doon Heritage School building is beautifully designed by Shashvat Shrotria, a very promising Architect presently doing his Masters in Architecture in Delf University Holland.

We truly believe that the school needs to have beautiful aesthetic surroundings to create positive and happy environment for our children so that it becomes an ideal learning place for them.

To add to this, we built an activity village Karma with Amphitheatre and many workshops and skill labs - Ruskin, Digital Library, Kalam, Robotics Lab, Abhivyakti theatre and Picasso Art and Craft are some of them. It provides suitable environment and resources to learn and hone their skills in various disciplines. The students are trained and mentored by experts of their field.

During COVID 19 years we built an indoor swimming pool designed on water conservation with recycling plant to keep water non-chlorinated and natural and learn the important lifesaving skill swimming.

We truly believe that common child of this country deserves all kinds of quality education hence DHS not only provides quality teaching but in addition has high standard sports facilities like basketball court, football field, TT and swimming pool etc.

As you all are aware that we got affiliation for Sr secondary school in 2017-18. Since then, we have made sure that we give equal opportunity to each and every child to channelize their potential in the best possible way.

This dream venture has grown in leaps n bounds in just 9 years of its establishment.

Growing from strength to strength in quality n quantity despite being hit by 2 consecutive years with covid 19. Our strength is 1400 plus students with largest senior section with 503 students. DHS has grown in leaps n bounds in just 9 years and has become the largest school in this area.

We offer all three streams I.e. Science, Commerce and Humanity to our senior students and arrange to provide the subject of their choice to them, .

Dear friends our first batch of Class 12 comprised of 90 students who passed out in 2019. DHS truly believes that that there is a topper in each child as we create a batch of toppers year after year.

Despite being COVID 19 year our dedicated and hard-working teachers did not leave any stones unturned and helped our children to produce yet another excellent result in **12th** board exams of **2021-22**

The 12th board result of 2021-22 was declared in July. We are extremely glad to share this with you that the passing batch comprising of 120 students produced 100% pass results. The highest percentage of 97% was obtained by Akriti Rana in Humanity and 96% by Abhinav Kumar in science along with Shivani Raturi. Tripti Chauhan scored 94% marks.

There were 19 students who scored more than 90% marks and 30% students scored more than 80% marks.

Akriti Rana who scored 97% marks in Humanity got admission in LSR Delhi. Shibani Raturi who scored 96% marks in science got admission in GB Pant Engineering college, Pant Nagar.

The 10th board result of 2021-22 was also upto the mark as again 100% pass out results by the batch 122 students. Abhishek Chaudhry scored 98% and stood 1st in DHS. 32 students scored above 90% and 5 students scored more than 95% marks.

So far Four batches of class 12th have passed out from Doon Heritage school and consistently produced excellent results and carved out a name for themselves and are getting recognition all around.

Our past-out students have secured admissions in Engineering, Medical colleges & National Defence Academy.

In 2020-21 12th board results Arjoo Singh who was the topper of the batch and scored 99%, got admission in St Stephens college, Delhi.

Sejal Singh with 98% cleared AIEEE and got admission in Pant Nagar Engineering college.

Reet Babbar with 96% got admission in Symbiosis, Pune.

We are very pleased to announce that Petroleum University (UPES), Dehradun and Graphic Era University have agreed to give 50% scholarship to Doon Heritage School students who take admission in their college.

This year 124 students are appearing for 12th board exam. We wish them good luck for their bright future and their upcoming board exams in February 2023.

In such a short span of time our students have not only produced one of the best 12th board results but also gave us many proud and glorious momenta year after year by outshining others at National and International level in different walks of life.

In 2018-19 our students won 25 Gold medals in science competition conducted by IIT Roorkee. After that they were awarded by dint of participation in the tech test 2019 held at Roorkee IIT.

Not only this, the DHS students won National Science Exhibition Award for Two consecutive years 2019 & 2020. For their best Robotics models. The students achieved this feat under the guidance under the Vice Principal OP Sharma.

Doon Heritage School has been awarded Atal Tinkering Lab Scholarship by Govt of India.

Two of our students Sonali Rawat and Anshika Dumaga went to Denmark to play International FIFA football tournament in 2020. They got 50% scholarship based on selection criteria.

Another star student of DHS was Maithili Rana of 2020 batch who was national player of Karate went to Malaysia and won gold medal and thus took the name & fame of DHS to International level.
